The NJUG London Street Works Forum will include:

- A series of **presentations** (2.15pm – 3.15pm)
- A **networking opportunity** over drinks and nibbles (3.15pm – 4.15pm)
- A **free visit to the zoo** (4.15pm – 5.15pm)

**Speeches** on the day will be given by Les Guest (NJUG CEO) and Martin Bradbury (Laing O'Rourke's Managing Director for Utilities) who will be opening proceedings. Shane Barber (Laing O'Rourke's Head of Proposals - Water) will be providing background on the two NJUG Awards Laing O'Rourke won last year for their Incident and Injury Free (IIF) - Behavioural Safety Programme and their programme to eliminate underground utility strikes. There will be an additional presentation on the Bewdley Town Centre mains replacement project which demonstrates how utilities, highway authorities and contractors can work effectively in partnership to minimise disruption.
